New process for Educators and their Students





LEARNING CONTENT TO WHICH WE ARE ENTITLED

Learning Libraries are linked to the Software Roles

- Learning Content is packaged into "Learning Libraries"
- There is a one to one mapping between the **3D**EXPERIENCE Roles and available Learning Libraries
- Academic Institutions are entitled to access the Learning Libraries that correspond to the roles they purchased
- The number of individuals entitled to access the Learning Libraries is determined by the number of licenses purchased
- Academic Institutions are responsible for providing the Learning Content access to their students, via a Voucher
- In addition to the Learning Libraries, Academic institution get access to the *Academic Content* developed by teachers and the *Getting Started Tutorials* developed for challenges and Student Projects

PROCESS OVERVIEW – STEP 1

1 – Requesting Access

- The Academic Institution representative (Teacher, School Advisor, ...) will request access to the Learning Content via either its DS Partner or the **3D**EXPERIENCE Edu Sales representative.
- The DS Partner or the **3D**EXPERIENCE Edu Sales representative will ask the **3D**EXPERIENCE Edu Support Team to enable Learning Libraries access for the Institution





PROCESS OVERVIEW – STEP 2

2 – Granting Access

- 3DEXPERIENCE Edu Support Team will setup access
- The Institution representative will receive an email from <u>Support.3DSEdu@3ds.com</u> with the Voucher ID
- The Institution representative will provide the Voucher to Teachers and Students





PROCESS OVERVIEW – STEP 3.1

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- 3 Accessing Learning Content
- Login to Edu Space 1.
- 2. Click "I have a registration voucher" link
- 3. Enter the Voucher ID

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4. Click to validate the Voucher







- Voucher activation has to be performed ONLY once by each user
